BRIAN DOHERTY TRIBUTE

The late Brian C. Doherty, for whom this event was named from the outset, was the inspiration for a basketball event that would highlight some of the top New Jersey teams, especially the two schools that were its anchors from the start – St. Benedict's Prep and St. Anthony H.S. A loyal graduate of St. Benedict's, Brian became a fan of St. Anthony basketball and a major supporter of the Jersey City school as well. His political activities and legal career enabled him to attract new friends to St. Anthony. Brian also helped St. Benedict's interest Dan Hurley, son of the legendary coach, Bob Hurley, in its coaching position, a post he held for nine years.

Following Brian's sudden death in August 2001, the two schools organized a basketball festival in his memory as a tribute to his concern for both schools and his love for basketball. St. Anthony and St. Benedict's were the key participants in the Brian C. Doherty Classic at St. Benedict's Dalton Gym since 2003-04. Other participants have included Bloomfield Tech, Blair Academy, East Side, Science, Shabazz (girls), and University from Newark, CBA, St. Joseph's and St. Peter's, and St. Patrick's.

The growing national prominence of New Jersey teams encouraged St. Benedict's as the host school to entertain a larger vision for the event. The principal owners of the Prudential Center, Jeff Vanderbeek and Mike Gilfillan, saw potential in an event featuring top quality New Jersey high school teams showcased in their spectacular new arena.

The event this year will again draw fans and attention from throughout the metropolitan area, well beyond the numbers of loyal alumni and fans of the area schools. The Newark National Invitational will continue to provide important support for scholarships for deserving students in the memory of the man who inspired it – the late Brian C. Doherty.

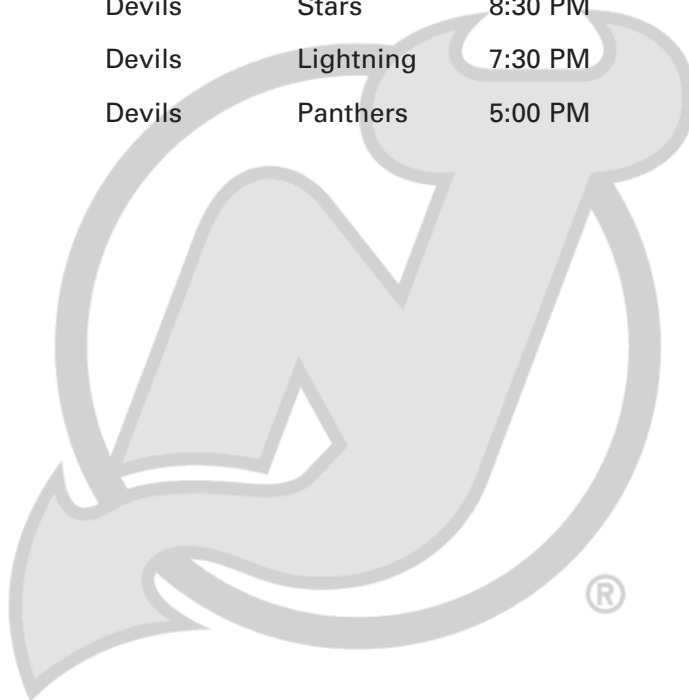
